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Experiential Learning at Greenville Technical College includes programs that promote applied learning opportunities for students, support quality curriculum development for faculty, and assist employers in meeting workforce development needs.

Experiential Learning at Greenville Technical College includes Co-op Programs, Technical Scholarship Programs and Apprenticeships.

Co-op Programs

The Co-op Program gives students the opportunity to gain valuable work experience in their fields of study while pursuing their degrees.

It benefits students by

- Providing work experience as they get a “foot in the door” of a reputable company
- Applying classroom knowledge to a real job
- Earning money while in school
- Testing career choices

Technical Scholarship Programs

The Scholars Programs provide students with part-time employment and scholarships from industry partners creating a pipeline of skilled employees to the sponsoring employers.

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships combine supervised on-the-job training with related technical instruction. Apprenticeships offer

- An employer-sponsored opportunity to learn in the classroom and on the job
- A wage component with incremental increases determined by the employer
- A benefit to S.C. employers by making them eligible for a \$1,000 annual tax credit for each apprenticeship employee for up to four years
