Beginning and Intermediate Level Greenville Literacy Association



Greenville Literacy Association is a community-based organization with locations throughout Greenville County. Schedules and Fees:

Classes are free to students after they pay the \$20 annual registration. A schedule of convenient morning and evening classes is available at each center. There is a computer lab fee for self-paced individual English practice at each center. Classes in conversation, pronunciation and citizenship are offered at specific locations.

Intermediate — Advanced Level Greenville Technical College



Greenville Technical College offers classes at high-intermediate to advanced levels in Listening/Speaking, Grammar, Reading and Writing & Pronunciation. These classes will help improve English skills and polish verbal communication for career advancement or continued education at the college level.

Registration:

Students must be at least 17 years old. Interested students must complete a GreenvilleTech application and take the COMPASS ESL placement test and then meet with an academic advisor for proper course placement.
