



## Clinical Requirements for Health and Wellness Student Health Records

The following checklist should be used by students accepted into any Health and Wellness Program. Each student must submit proof of the following items. NO exceptions can or will be made regarding submission of documentation by a medical professional.

ITEM	DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED	CHECKOFF
<b>Health Form</b>	Initial Physical examination must have occurred within 12 months of admission to program. Page 2 must be completed by a licensed practicing physician or Certified Nurse Practitioner. <b>ALL</b> requested information must be completed with supporting documentation attached. <b>Process could take up to 30 days to complete.</b>	
<b>MMR (Rubeola, Mumps , and Rubella)</b>	Documentation of two <b>MMR</b> immunizations or titers that indicate immunity for Rubeola, Mumps, and Rubella required. If negative or equivocal titer, series required. (Do not test for immunity if MMR vaccines are documented.) MMR documentation or titer lab results must be attached.	
<b>Tetanus/Diphtheria/ Pertussis</b>	Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap) within 10 years CDC recommends a single dose of Tdap for healthcare personnel who have not previously received Tdap, and who have direct patient contact. Tdap should be administered regardless of interval since the previous Td booster. After receipt of Tdap, a Td booster is recommended every 10 years.	
<b>Influenza</b>	<b>FLU vaccines are required by most H&amp;W programs.</b>	
<b>PPD (TB skin test)</b>	Initial 2-Step PPD is required. Documentation with placement date, read date and results must be attached. Annual PPD's are required throughout program. If you have ever tested positive for TB, you must submit documentation of the positive PPD results, copy of x-ray report, and physician statement of clearance. Also you will be required to complete an annual TB questionnaire. Quantiferon Gold® or T-Spot® testing may be accepted in place of Tuberculosis skin test.	
<b>Varicella</b>	Two immunizations with documentation, or titers indicating immunity with titer lab results attached.	
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	Hepatitis B series which includes 3 vaccines with follow up titer is recommended but not required; however, signature on the Hepatitis B information sheet is required. If initially starting series at this time please provide documentation as series progresses.	
<b>Meningitis</b>	Meningitis Vaccine is highly recommended for students living in campus housing.	
<b>CPR</b>	Documentation of current CPR certification. Two year CPR must be <b>Health Care Provider Adult/Child/Infant</b> . Only courses by the American Heart Association is accepted. <b>MLT and HIM do not require CPR.</b>
