

GTC DMS Weighted Admission Addendum

Important notes about the sections on the Weighted Admission Form---Please view the [Career Talk](#) and then read this document carefully, so you will be eligible for the application period in spring:

Section A

- Minimum GPA of **3.0 required**. Good grades, in Section A, are **very** important.
- BIO and physics courses must have been taken within the **last 5 years**. No exceptions. See your advisor for assistance.
- Review the University Transfer List in the [GTC catalog](#) to see which classes are considered a [Humanities](#) course
 - If a foreign language is chosen to satisfy the Humanities requirement, the course must be at the 102 level or higher.

While other health programs at Greenville Tech may take various kinds of volunteer activities, please remember that in order to receive credit for DMS volunteer time, all volunteer hours must be **hospital-based**. No other types of volunteer time will be accepted.

Documentation requirements are as follows: **NO EXCEPTIONS**

- A letter on **hospital letterhead** should be submitted with the Weighted Admission form.
- The letter should be completed by a **volunteer services coordinator**. The letter must be dated and **signed** by that person with a phone number or email denoted so we can contact them to **verify** your hours of service. We do verify.
- **100 hours of service**: The letter must state **which** departments you rotated through, the date(s) and how many hours were spent in **each** department.
- **6-8 hours observing in an ultrasound lab**: MUST be completed **as part of** (or in addition to) the 100 hours above. If your letter does not have specific information about your rotation in an ultrasound lab, stating that you were **observing ultrasound scans on actual patients**, you will **not** be eligible for the extra points on the weighted admissions form. We want you to **see** what an ultrasound scans consists of so you can determine your level of interest in this career field.
- Please note that most of our accepted students completed the volunteer time! We believe that not only is it important for you to see what a career in ultrasound looks like, it *might* also be necessary for you to do this *to be accepted* to our program.

Work Experience

- You cannot receive work experience points without a W2 and/or a **signed** letter from your employer stating the **dates** that you were employed (verifying at least 6 months) and **providing contact information**.
