

**Emergency
Written Determination**

Agency Identification: Greenville Technical College

Describe the nature of the emergency condition and the resulting immediate threat to public health, welfare, critical economy and efficiency, or safety that this procurement responded to: Anthology's bankruptcy and the resulting termination of the ERP contract was an unforeseen disruption that has prevented the College from completing a standard competitive solicitation and awarding a replacement agreement before expiration of the current Civitas contract. Absent continuity of service, the College would immediately lose access to critical operational tools that support student success and daily administration, including early alert functionality used to identify and intervene with at-risk students and the primary platform used to coordinate advising appointments across student support functions. The combination of an unanticipated system disruption and the imminent expiration of a dependent contract present an immediate operational risk that cannot be mitigated within standard procurement timelines and therefore supports an emergency procurement determination.

Describe the facts and circumstances giving rise to the above describe emergency condition and threat: As part of the planned Anthology implementation, predictive analytics functionality was expected to be incorporated into the new student information system. When the Anthology contract was terminated prior to full implementation, the scope of the existing Predictive Analytics RFP was no longer sufficient and the solicitation process had to be revised and restarted. Because the current Civitas Learning contract expires in October 2026, and because multiple procurements are already underway as a result of the Anthology cancellation, the College does not have sufficient time to complete a new competitive solicitation and award a replacement contract before the current agreement expires.

Agency has contracted with or plans to contract with Emergency Vendor for the supplies, services, information technology, or construction described below per S.C. Code Ann. §11-35-1570 and S.C. Regulation 19-445.2110, Emergency Procurement.

Emergency Vendor: Civitas Learning

Basis for Selection of the Vendor—In the initial RFP for a Predictive Analytics solution, the market was thoroughly explored. Revisiting the field during the proposed Anthology implementation provided an additional opportunity to reassess available vendors. Civitas Learning remains the strongest option because its platform offers institution-specific predictive models, individual student prediction scores, integrated communication capabilities, a built-in scheduling platform, and strong reporting and analytics functionality that allow the College to act on insights in a coordinated and timely way.

Description of supplies, services, information technology, or construction: We need a one-year renewal of the existing contract for Inspire with Civitas Learning to allow enough time to complete a new RFP.

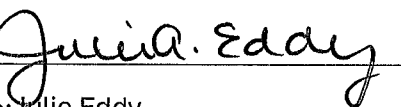
